

Beer Board Minutes

The Shelbyville Beer Board met in Regular Session on November 18, 2015 at the Shelbyville Recreation Center Meeting Room. Chairman Jason Reeves called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Roll was called and the following members were present: Member Sandra Hughes, Member Melissa York, Member Brett Fisher, Member Jason Finney, and Chairman Reeves. Also present were City Attorney Shofner, Deputy Chief Mike Rogers, and City Recorder Shanna Boyette.

Chairman Reeves called for any items to be added or removed from the Agenda. Hearing none, Member Fisher made a motion to approve the Agenda, seconded by Member Hughes, and carried unanimously upon oral vote.

The next item of business was approval of the Regular and Special Session Minutes of October 14, 2015. Chairman Reeves called for any corrections or revisions to the minutes and further confirmed that all members received a copy of both sets of minutes. Hearing no request for corrections, Member Fisher made a motion to approve the Regular and Special Session Minutes, seconded by Member Hughes, and carried unanimously upon oral vote.

The only item of Old Business was report by City Staff on Civil penalty collections. City Recorder Boyette reported that all Civil Penalties issued by the Board in October were paid within the required time frame.

Items of New Business were then in Order.

Consideration of an application to sell beer (package) by Dolgencorp, LLC dba Dollar General Store #3051. Frances Scott, District Manager at 1023 Madison Street Shelbyville, Tennessee was the next item on the Agenda. Chairman Reeves called for the District Manager Scott to come forward. It was requested that Frances Scott state name and position within the company for the record. Frances Scott was then sworn in by the City Recorder. Chairman Reeves confirmed that a copy of the Beer Rules and Ordinance were received of which Mrs. Scott stated that they were sent to corporate and she had no questions in regards to either on behalf of the company or herself individually. Ms. Scott noted that Dollar General held a beer permit in Shelbyville prior to relocating the store. Ms. Scott provided history of permit holder, no prior issues with permit and noted that training has been provided to all employees. Ms. Scott further stated that she understands/recognizes violation of selling to minors and will uphold law. Member Fisher inquired on attachments referenced on the application of which Recorder Boyette provided and further reported background check is good. Additionally statement from property owner was submitted to the Board. There being no further questions Chairman Reeves called for a motion of the Members. Member York made a motion to approve the beer permit application, seconded by Member Hughes, and carried unanimously upon oral vote.

The next item on the Agenda was review and discussion on Shelbyville Police Report(s) in regards to Leo's Lounge 203 East Depot Street Shelbyville, Tennessee. The owners Mary Gonzales O'Donnell and Kevin P. O'Donnell were present at the meeting. Attorney Shofner provided comments noting that the item before the Board is a discussion item only and not an action item. Attorney Shofner further

provided options within jurisdiction to the Board. There being no further discussion, Member York made a motion to issue a Show Cause Order to owners of Leo's Lounge to come before the Beer Board in December. The motion was seconded by Member Hughes and carried unanimously upon oral vote.

There being no further business of the Board, Member York made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Member Hughes, and carried unanimously upon oral vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:11 p.m.
