

Beer Board Minutes

The Shelbyville Beer Board met on June 10, 2015 in regular session at City Hall Annex. Chairman Woodlee called the meeting to order at 6:14 p.m. Roll was called and the following members were present: Member Lindsey, Member Hastings, and Chairman Woodlee. Member Reeves and Member York were absent. Also present was City Recorder Shanna Boyette.

Chairman Woodlee called for any items to be added or removed from the Agenda. City Recorder Boyette requested that the new beer application and checklist be added to the Agenda for review and discussion. Member Hastings made a motion to amend the Agenda, seconded by Member Lindsey, and carried unanimously upon oral vote. Member Hastings made a motion to approve the Agenda as amended, seconded by Member Lindsey, and carried unanimously upon oral vote.

The next item on the Agenda was approval of the minutes from the meeting of April 8, 2015. Chairman Woodlee called for any revisions or corrections. Chairman Woodlee confirmed that everyone had received and read the minutes. Member Hastings made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Member Lindsey, and carried unanimously upon oral vote.

There were no items of Old Business before the Board.

Items of New Business were then in order. There were no applications for consideration. City Recorder provided each member a copy of a new beer permit application and checklist for board members to use at meetings. Members were asked to review and provide any suggestions or recommendations for either document at the next meeting. In addition it was noted that the application and checklist can both be revised at the Administrative level. The new beer permit application will request information from the applicant that is referenced in the application requirements set forth in the newly adopted Beer Ordinance effective April 1, 2015.

City Recorder Boyette thanked the outgoing members; Lindsey, Hastings, & Woodlee for their service to the Board and to the City of Shelbyville.

There being no further business before the Board, Member Hastings made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Member Lindsey, and carried unanimously upon oral vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:29 p.m.
