

Beer Board Minutes

The Shelbyville Beer Board met on Wednesday, March 11, 2015 at City Hall Annex in Regular Session. Chairman Woodlee called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Roll was called and the following members were present: Member Melissa York, Member Dianne Hastings, Member Jason, Reeves, and Chairman Wanda Woodlee. Member David Lindsey was absent. Also present were City attorney Ginger B. Shofner, City Recorder Shanna Boyette, and Deputy Chief Mike Rogers.

The first item of business was approval of the Agenda. Member Reeves made a motion to approve the Agenda as submitted. The motion was seconded by Member Hastings and approved by all upon oral vote.

The next item of business was approval of the minutes from the Regular Session meeting of January 14, 2015 and the Special Called Meeting January 28, 2015. Member Hastings made a motion to approve the minutes of both meetings as submitted, seconded by Member Reeves, and approved unanimously upon oral vote. There was no February meeting of the Beer Board as there were no applications received.

Chairman Woodlee called for items of Old Business. Hearing none, New Business was then in order. There was one item of new business before the Board, consideration of an application to sell beer (package) by Helen Burgos at 1314 Madison Street Shelbyville, TN, Mimi's Market & Deli.

Chairman Woodlee called for the applicant Helen Burgos. The applicant was then sworn in by Shanna Boyette City Recorder. The application of Helen Burgos to sell beer (package) at 1314 Madison Street, Mimi's Market & Deli was then before the Board.

Chairman Woodlee asked the applicant if she had any experience in selling beer of which the applicant replied that she had not had experience. The applicant, Ms. Burgos did advise that she had read and understood the rules. Chairman Woodlee advised of the seriousness of selling beer to a minor and confirmed that the business had software in place that helped prevent the sell to a minor. Chairman Woodlee also advised that the parking lot was also the responsibility of the permit holder and that the permit was to sell package only, no consumption on property.

Chairman Woodlee asked if the applicant had any questions for the Board. The applicant had one question in regards to the definition of brown bagging. With no additional questions, Member Reeves made a motion to approve the permit, seconded by Member York, and carried unanimously upon oral vote.

Chairman Woodlee called for any other items of New Business. Hearing none, Member Hastings made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Member York, and carried unanimously upon oral vote. The meeting adjourned at 6:03 p.m.
